LFMK caught up with Anne Veenstra from Warp Music to have a chat about life, the universe and everything regarding the local music scene.

OUCH!!! Where did you come from and what brought you here?

ANNE I came from my mum.

OUCH!!! What made you start the shop? What's your musical background for a start?

ANNE Um, I've been involved in the music industry since about 1985.

OUCH!!! So we're talking about approximately 10 years?

ANNE About that.

OUCH!!! Always in Western Australia?

ANNE No!

OUCH!!! Ok, where were you before you came to Western Australia?

ANNE I started in Western Australia then over to Melbourne. Spent six years in

Melbourne.

OUCH!!! Doing what?

ANNE (Laughs) Just working. I worked in the bank funnily enough. Then I was in

bands part time.

OUCH!!! Singing?

ANNE Yes! When I got back to Western Australia in 1994 I realised that the industry

was in pretty much the same situation as when I left it six years previously.

OUCH!!! So from the outsider's point of view ... an insider, outsider, then insider's point

of view again you can honestly say having left the industry for six years, and coming back to the industry, you still saw the same pitfalls and problems that

were there six years before?

ANNE · Correct.

OUCH!!! So you're saying there hasn't been a lot of progress made?

ANNE Well from what I believe, well I believe there has been. But then it's sort of

gone in fits and starts I s'pose. It's improved and then died again and then better improvement and so on. So this opportunity came to purchase this place

and I did, not knowing what I was going to do.

OUCH!!! Where, where did the uh, what's , what was the um, apart from the obvious,

what was the motivation to actually go with the record and CD sales exclusively

West Australian? (mutual giggling) What's so funny?

ANNE It was this major intelligent guru that I know.

OUCH!!! Yeh!

ANNE His name's Chris Gibbs.

OUCH!!! (Chuckle) Yeh?

ANNE And I was having a yak with Chris once and he was telling me about what a

great idea to go exclusively West Australian product.

OUCH!!! Well, ... I know Chris Gibbs.

ANNE Do you?

OUCH!!! And I can say he's just a ...
ANNE He's a guru! What can I say?

OUCH!!! He does a lot of thankless work for the industry and really... what can I say?

(Inanc laughter)

ANNE And he's a loser!

OUCH!!! He's a loser as well, there's no doubt about that. Ok, so you started this thing off, um, how's the response been first of all from the bands managers and

whoever you've been speaking to to get the product into here?

ANNE Um, The actual industry, it's been really supportive, the bands have been just, greatful's the word. Everyone's been saying "Oh wow, what a great thing to do." However, public perception hasn't changed, I mean it's all well and good for the industry to be behind us but the whole idea is to get the public involved and to know that there's good original music out and around, and that's the

difficult bit.

OUCH!!! Ok. Anne, lets have a quick talk about the actual record retail side of you're little business is known as WARP MUSIC, however Public Music still exists and will reexist as a fully functioning recording studio. What services are you making available to the public and the bands? What's your aim?

ANNE Well, going back to the original concept of Public Music, it was for the general public to come up and use, so it was in the height of kareoke where people came up and put their own vocals over backing tracks. We maintain that service and as far as bands are concerned, we are offering demo recordings

OUCH!!! How many tracks have you got? What have you got in there?

ANNE Eight.

OUCH!!! So it's an eight track set up.

ANNE Yep. It's an analogue; but we do have access to DAT if you want to.

OUCH!!! So you're mixing just to reel?

ANNE At this stage yeh.

OUCH!!! How can the bands and related music industry get behind you further more to

promote Warp Music?

ANNE I guess Warp Music will stay and when the studio's up and running we will predominantly be a studio. The CD and original music product will still be a service that we're offering to the bands and musicians of Perth. The only thing I ask for of musicians is obviously that when they release something they let us know and let us get it in here. It's awfully difficult for us to chase everything up. Secondly, when advertising or telling people where to get it make sure they mention us as an outlet.

OUCH!!! Anything else you want to add?

ANNE Oh, we're really cheap, our recording's really cheap,

OUCH!!! How cheap?

ANNE It's only 8 hours for 150 bucks...

FLANDERS: SPADEWORK

I hadn't heard much of FLANDERS before this review, but I'm sure to change that after hearing SPADEWORK.

From the opening chords of Shameless you can't help but get hooked on the good time vibe created by the band. Classic pop ideas come across in a familiar, yet refreshing way. Coming from the same side of the fence as hometown heroes AMMONIA, the band give clear indication that they may soon follow a similar path to success. The vocals in tracks 3 (Spadework) & 4 (Demon(for sweet lovin')) have me continually recalling visions of a young Dave Faulkner......or occasionally Johnstone. Simple yet oh so effective instrumentation makes sure that nothing is crowding the alluring vocal work, while occassionally it's those simple riffs that have some of the best hooks (check out track 3, Spadework). Others tracks on SPADEWORK are Yellow Oats, Sleep and Ant's Clown.

Thickened with large gobs of those good ol' melodies, FLANDERS have a disc that's as sweet, smiley and hey-diddly-ho-neighbour as the Ned of the same name.

WATERMOUTH: THE FLOWERS ARE NO LONGER RARE

WATERMOUTH's second tape is a great offering from a band beginning to make a mark on the Perth scene. This is the first recording after a major line-up reshuffle, with new members Ned Goodwin vocals / guitar, lead guitarist Scott Glew and drummer Adrian Hickey joining the remaining members Dave Delahunty and Scott Morris.

Recorded at Witzend studios by Alan Dawson, the tape finds WATERMOUTH moving from a very reflective, melancholy mood, evident in such tracks as Watermouth and Odd through to a more intense, harder edge like Prove Me Wrong. Lyrically, a love of storytelling is portrayed, while musically the band cover a wide area of styles, whilst retaining that which makes the band WATERMOUTH. Other tracks rounding out this six song tape are Two Cars On A Hill, Tabitha's Ransom and Static.

With the change of line-up and all the inherent problems associated in finding new musicians of similar outlook, WATERMOUTH have kept the same feel and flow to their music that was evident on their first cassette, *Firelight*, whilst enhancing the effect of such. If you liked the first, you're sure to love the second.

Grab a copy of this from the usual outlets and find out for yourself how it all happens.

GREENROOM: BEEN HERE BEFORE

In a relatively short period of time, GREENROOM have established themselves as a popular live act and some of their coolest songs are on offer here. The most impressive thing about these guys, is that their songs are written with plenty of variety as far as arrangements go and yet have an instant, infectious likeability about them.

Much of this can be attributed to Jeremy Hart's clear pop-sensible vocals. This tape was recorded live with no overdubs and as such there are a few minor timing glitches, but as a lead up to full production CD plans, BEEN HERE BEFORE is a great sign of things to come. Highlights are Smoke The Rent, Greenroom and Alibi.

The original run of 200 copies have already sold out and a second batch is disappearing fast so get with the winning team and experience GREENROOM before it's too late! An excellent opener from a band on the rise.

THE FALLEN: THRESHOLD

THRESHOLD opens with a kick in the face number entitled *Empty Rocket*. From the outset I could hear a BLACK SABBATH influence welded to a more nineties SOUNDGARDEN / FAITH NO MORE approach, yet there is a refreshing originality to this band's style which I can't quite put my finger on.

Jo Pintaudi's vocals are nothing short of brilliant and guitarist Dave Morris can certainly crank out a dangerous lick or two, while the whole soundscape travels effortlessly between absolute aggression and solemn, soothing passages. A good example of this styling is *Box*. My favourite track, however is the closer, *Centralize*, which absolutely kicks. Add this to your collection and check THE FALLEN out ASAP. Loving It !!!
