FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE 25TH ANNIVERSARY iHOBBY EXPO™ WAS A SPECTACULAR SUCCESS!

October 27, 2009. Despite a very challenging economy and significant softening in the retail sector, the 25th Anniversary edition of iHobby Expo™ broke the all-time record for consumer attendance during the weekend of October 24 and 25. Total attendance for the public days was 20,606 with 10% more adults, 50% more seniors, and 75% more children attending the model hobby extravaganza this year over 2008. Saturday's attendance of 12,058 was the highest one day consumer day in the show's history. The two day trade and two day public event was held at the Donald E. Stephens Convention Center, Rosemont, IL.

"We are extremely gratified that model hobby enthusiasts and brand new consumers in the Chicago area came out to the iHobby Expo to enjoy the wonderful world of hobbies," stated Michael Bass (Stevens International), newly installed president of the Hobby Manufacturers

Association, sponsors of the event. "Our two day event was packed full of radio control cars, planes, trucks and helicopters, model trains, plastic and die cast models, robotics, toys, games, and activities for every age. Our show floor presented the best that we in the model hobby industry have to offer and our thanks to all our exhibitors, retailers, and volunteers for contributing to the success of the 2009 anniversary show," added Bass.

The trade portion of the four day event drew 4,982 total exhibitor and buyer attendees with 1,727 verified buyer attendees from 980 retail stores/distributorships. This compares to 1,784 retailer/distributor personnel representing 1,002 stores and distributorships who attended in 2008. 254 exhibitors (79 new to the show) took 609 booths, close to 61,000 square feet of exhibit space.

"We had a good show - a number of very good leads. We look forward to exhibiting again in 2010," said Stephanie Acton of Tri-Technical Systems, Inc.

In addition to the action-packed show floor featuring many opportunities to see hobby products in action (including the Traxxas Dirt Track, Empire Hobby Flying Cage, Biq Squid Race Track, MRC's Slot Car Track, Chicagoland Hobby's Pinewood Derby Track, and Thunder Tech's Monster Truck Track), attendees experienced the third Phoenix Cup competition of professional airplane flyers where nationally ranked pilots from across the U.S. competed for cash and prizes in the various flying competitions held on Saturday and Sunday. The Mecha Mayhem Robotics Battle Zone, Truck Pulling Track and Rock Crawler Events were all smash hits. The Chicago Area Robotics Group (Chibots) also returned to the Expo this year to hold their "Fall Chibotica Contest" - interactive robot competitions featuring national and regional competitors and a robotic seminar for

consumers. Youngsters enjoyed the Thomas the Tank Engine Kiddie Train Ride and a Legoland play area.

Appearing at the Expo on Friday and Saturday was Michael Gross, actor and model train hobbyist. Michael appeared in the long-running sitcom "Family Ties" as the dad, Stephen Keaton, and currently appears in the daytime soap opera, The Young and the Restless. Former Chicago Bears Defensive End and Super Bowl Champion, Steve "Mongoo" McMichael, also tried his hand at the various radio control activity areas and signed autographs on Saturday.

HMA continued its retailer certificate series of educational seminars, "Hobby University" with an extremely well-attended program on surviving in a tough retail economy. "Retail experts, Kizer and Bender, presented this seminar and were also on hand to assist retailers find answers to their business issues," said Pat Koziol, HMA Executive Director. "All the seminars were very well attended and we will be issuing certificates of completion to the retailers who attended. The fourth year of the Ticket to Ride program generated over \$30,000 of exhibitor coupon requests to give out at the Expo. Also, this year's Expo included "Dealer Paks" of products that retailers could purchase at significant savings. Dealer attendees need to send their Ticket to Ride coupons and travel receipts to the HMA office by November 30, 2009 in order to redeem payment.

Ed Rogala, HMA Show Committee Chair, thanked the numerous clubs and volunteers for their assistance in helping consumers at the make and take areas and presenting their train layouts on the show floor. "Without their volunteer efforts, we could not offer the range of activities and projects for the public to see and experience at the show," stated Rogala. "Our thanks as well to our 25th Anniversary party sponsors, National Retail Hobby

Stores Association, Electronic Model Systems, and B2B Replicas for their most generous contributions," added Rogala.

START UP?

John

I grew up racing slot cars in the 70's in the mid-west on the old wood tracks you could find on every corner shop. My father got me involved when I was old enough to see over the edge the track. I went away from it for a while and now live in NJ and have been racing on a 95' long 7 1/2' x 15' digital scalextric layout set up in my basement for a few years. I have a few friend and family member who have been tossing around the idea of opening up a raceway. All of the hobby shops around here are concentrating on the R/C and model business. We want to do something for slot racing only with dif-

ferent race classes 3-4 times a week. We are search around the country trying to find some commercial tracks in good condition (absolutely need a "king"), and we have figured out a way to power-up and race up to 40 cars on a 6 lane digital track using slot.it brand controllers and chips. Our biggest problem has been trying to find a building around 5000 sf with a reasonable leasable rate.

I have two questions for you sir: one is can I order the magazine and have it mail to me every month until we are open, and two is in today economy what kind of revenue do you perceive we can expect. I here horror stories from the industry I work in of people losing businesses everyday. Note we already have a following of about 18-24 people who want to race and join a league. Quite a few of them race with me on my home track. We are planning on about \$25,000.00 in start-up and track set-up. We also figured about \$7,000.00 / month in running cost (this may change based on lease rate of building). You have been doing this for almost as long as I am living so you have seen the "ups" and the "downs", I am looking for a little wisdom and advice from the "god-father of scaled racing".

SPOTLIGHT ON



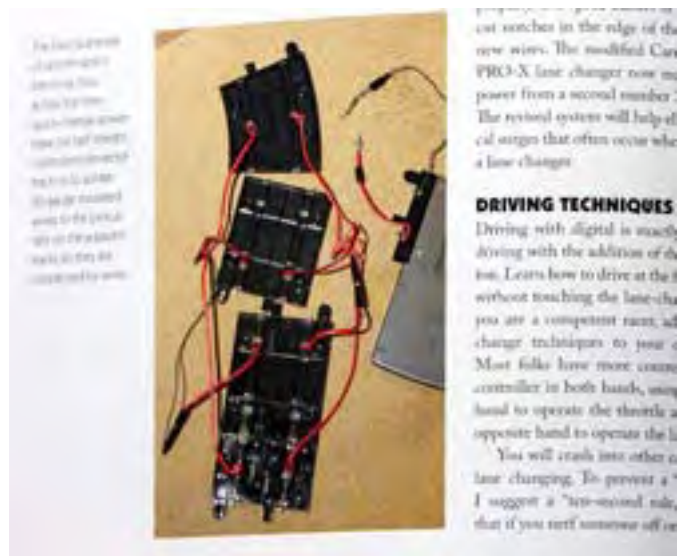
This is the latest update in the series of books from the publisher of Model Car Racing magazine: Racing and Collecting Slot Cars (2001), Slot Car Bible (2002) and Slot Car Racing: Tips, Tricks & Track Plans (2005). This edition builds on the introduction to Digital in Slot Car Racing: Tips, Tricks & Track Plans, has more tuning tips, Test Results, Track Plans in both 1/32 and HO Scales, as well as, interestingly, features some racetracks of people I have met through Slot Car Illustrated. The chapter Real Racing in 1/32 Scale describes chip installation, some Pros & Cons and has tips to modify the Carrera Digital 132, Ninco N-Digital, Scalextric Sport Digital and SCX Digital Systems, including continuity improvement and modifying track pieces to allow Digital OR Analog racing on the same track.

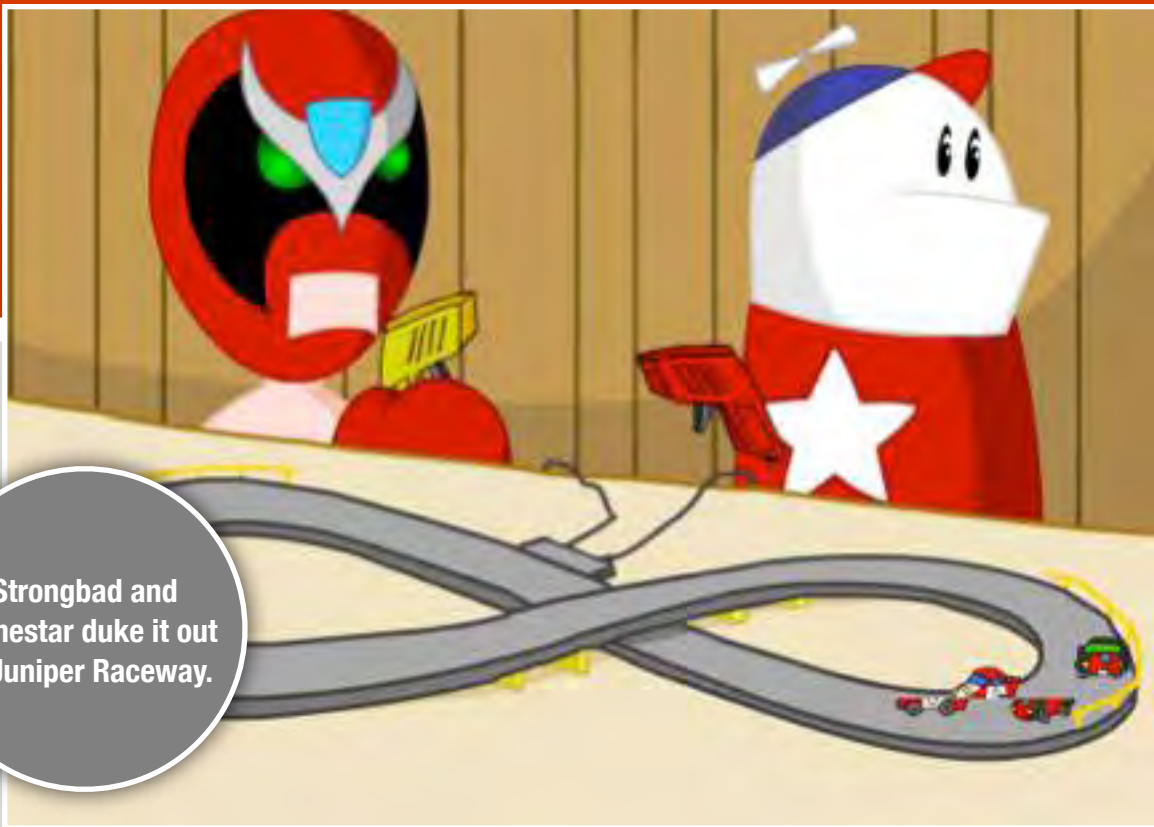
In the chapter on replacing chassis, the only Slot.it motors mentioned for the original HRS Chassis are either the SIM*04 V12/2b (white endbell) or now discontinued Boxer 24. While the SIM*09 Flat-6 Motor is mentioned in passing, the only hint of the now-standard SIM*06 V12/3-21.5K (orange endbell) is in a picture of the Slot.it 312PB kit incorrectly captioned "Carrera 2005 Corvette C6R". The more powerful versions of the V12/3, SIM*08 Boxer/2 and the more versatile HRS/2 chassis are not mentioned either, possibly due to publishing lead time or this book cleans up the loose ends before starting fresh with another in the future.

Again, there are a lot of track plans in this edition, for small to large spaces, with most based on actual race tracks and many to fit a 5' X 9' Ping Pong table. While I can understand a reluctance to use R1 ("inner" or "inner inner") track pieces, especially for newer racers, some of the layouts would need a lot more of them to even remotely resemble their full size counterparts. Having routed a 6-Lane, 78' version of Suzuka, I know the difficulty in compressing a reasonable facsimile of a historic track. One of the finest, most spectacular slot car tracks I have ever seen is pictured. The now-defunct HO Katz-Spa-Ring had fantastic elevations, with scenery and detail to rival any

model railroad.

This book, like the others in the series, also serves as a summary for Model Car Racing magazine track tests as well as car comparisons using a variety of tires and, in some cases, motors. For relative newcomers to Slot Car Racing, Slot Car Racing in the Digital Age is a good overview of the hobby from its revival with the arrival of FLY in the mid-'90s and the advent of Digital Racing to the relative present. There have been a lot of new cars and parts released as well as significant innovations in the last few years that are not covered. Fortunately, Model Car Racing magazine and Slot Car Illustrated exist to help with that.

08-09 MARC RACING SEASON: JUNIPER 2

Saturday, March 28th, the 9th round of the 2008 - 2009 MARC racing season rolled in to Juniper Raceway in Southbridge MA. With 9 entries in the hotly contested G-Jet class and 10 entries in Ceramic Modified (Noooooooooooo, not on the Banzai!) the racing promised to be fast and furious!

After an hour and a half of practice and thrashing, the first group of four racers took to the track. After 5 minutes per lane, Rob Hayes had 303 laps, followed by John Pileggi with 290, John Stezelecki with 284, and Joe Eastlack with 280. Mid-point through this these heats, Benny Leyro arrived on site. Claiming, "I don't need no stinking practice", he jumped right in to the next heat of 5 racers. Run round-robin style, this second set of heats saw Tom Gray post 255 laps, followed by Gerry On Cullan with 247, Paul Ryer with 233, Benny "I still don't need no stinking practice" Leyro with 209, and Durf Hyson with 200 laps.

Breaking out Pro and Amateur standings, Rob Hayes lead the pro's with 303 laps, John Pileggi in 2nd with 290 laps, John Stezelecki 3rd with 284 laps, Joe Eastlack 4th with 280 laps, and Tom Gray 255 laps.

H.O. REVIEW

So the AFX claims about their making a better looking and more detailed body seem to be true... is it going to prove the AFX claims in the performance department though?

Body lifted off and there is no denying it's a slick narrow chassis that no doubt gives AFX the freedom they claim it does to create that more realistic body. It looks long and lean and maybe a little mean but the track test will tell the tale.



Those rectangular box openings on the side are the body connection points. The chassis, while narrow, also has what is in my opinion a very short side profile with the overall chassis height being roughly half the height of the cars rear tires. Notice the snap in points for all of the cars go-fast parts. To that point the motor parts were very snug in the chassis and I feared breaking something trying to get the motor out. I eventually decided I could see everything I needed to see without pulling it out of the chassis and I left well enough alone.

Made in China' stamped on the side, AFX stamped on the bottom and 'Hot Do Not Touch' on the plastic heat shield. Here you get a look at the guide pin, pick up shoes and traction magnets.



Gearing and the rear axle have just the slightest amount of side to side movement yet the gear stays mostly clear of contacting any surface of the actual chassis. The closest point, the plastic on the



side of the traction magnet on the right side of the gear in the image above, does appear to make contact on the back side of the crown yet from the looks of it that contact might be intentional as it restricts lateral movement of the axle as a whole. If it supposed to be this way I don't know but I'm going to keep a little grease on it just to help reduce possible friction and wear.



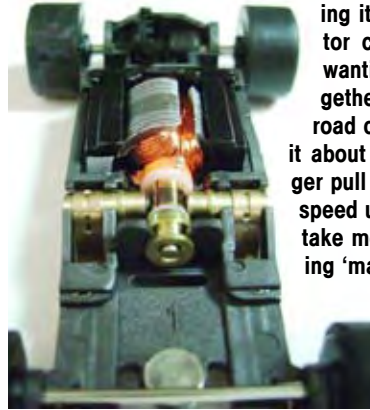
The front axle is not positionable like some HO cars I've owned in the past. It also doesn't snap in and out so removing a front wheel is the way to get the axle out if need be. Should you need to remove the axle? In my case the answer is maybe as spinning the front wheels and watching them and the axle rotate I noticed one slightly wobbly rim as well as a slightly 'less than straight' axle. I removed the tire on the wobbly wheel just to make certain I wasn't being fooled by an out of round tire yet with the rubber off the rim wobbled all the sam



Speaking of wheels the rears are the single lipped versions and I'm told by a couple local HO racers that they prefer this rim design. The rear tires were snug on the rims and did not spin freely on the rims as I tried just to turn the tires by themselves.

Giving the car some throttle before sending it off on it's maiden voyage the motor certainly feels like an angry beast wanting to tear up some plastic snap-together track. Having set up a small Tyco road course on my basement floor I gave it about 15 or so laps at roughly half trigger pull and quickly gave it more and more speed until soon it was a black blur. Didn't take me too long and I was already thinking 'man! I need a track with some longer straight to open this baby up!' This is where I had to turn to others and thankfully local HO racer Steve Nemoff stepped up with an offer to run at his place. And boy oh boy, what a track!



Wait, let me rephrase that, what tracks!! Steve has both a killer 2 lane HO track to race on but if you're daring enough you can try driving around the track dodging three or four separate railroad lines that cross right in front of you. Here is where I was able to really open things up. The comment of 'corners better than any other chassis' was questioned first as my speeds got faster and faster the car seemed more determined to off at the same turns on Steve's track. Thinking it might be just my rusty driving skills I asked Steve to take it for a run and even with his knowledge of his tracks little tricks it was interesting that he too was having offs at the same turns I was having problems with. Running some of Steve's other HO cars we didn't have the same issues in the same places so something about this Mega-G didn't like several specific spots on Steve's track. We worked with it though and a slight throttle adjustment to the 'less trigger' side had the car making its way perhaps a little slower in that section but clawing back some time on the long high speed straights. Overall I'm willing to say that AFX has the right to claim this is perhaps one of the fastest stock cars but with a 20% more powerful motor, 'glued to the track' level 30 Neodymium traction magnets mounted in a skinny, hair off the track, chassis shouldn't it be smoking quick?

The first order of business was to present trophies to the top three finishers in each class in the recently completed FVSRA VINTAGE Racing Series. Terry Tawney, Greg Walker and Count Gibson were tops in GT. Terry, Count and Bill Colvard headed all CAN-AM racers.

Once we cut the cake, it was time for WOMPS! The twenty five entries were divided into Amateur and Experienced classes (as were all the classes on the night). Rockledge's Mark "Petro" Petronaci led by five laps after the first three segments. Mark's disastrous fourth segment on white allowed Ethan Hausler (Palm Bay) to take the point at half-way. Mark hung around the top three until the final segment when Daulton Chouinard (Okeechobee) drove around him and Joan Rohnock (Clermont) to steal second. Ethan took the win, Joan finished third and recorded fast lap (2.250), with Daulton running best segment (36).

The Experienced WOMP field was the largest of the night. In the interest of time, we divided the group into two races with total laps totals determining overall finish. The first race gave us the fastest laps as Bob Rondinone (Melbourne) and Jeff Gross (Palm Bay) tied for that honor (2.140). The second race, however, produced the most laps. Steve Bowman (Palm Bay) took a two lap win over Bill Colvard (Merritt Island) with Terry Tawney (Cocoa) completing the podium. Best segment (39) was shared by Steve, Bill, Bob and Jeff.

We had a modest turnout of 4.5" Stock Cars. It was a very fast field, however, as six cars broke the 2 second barrier for the first time. The rest of the field was at 2.0. Fastest was Lakeland's John Davis (1.866). Sebring's Phil Sloan took a narrow win over Terry Tawney with Count Gibson (Port St. John) getting third. Phil and John shared best segment (44).

S-ROCs finished up the evening. S-ROC is eight identical cars that stay on their designated lane as the racers rotate through the main using "house" controllers. That way, each racer races all eight cars using eight different controllers. Thanks again to Greg Walker at the Race Place in Holly Hill for providing the cars and to Jim Difalco who sent a prototype "rental" controller for us to try. His controller stayed on the yellow lane for WOMPS and SROC, and in every main, fast time was set on yellow (normally when house controllers are used, fast time is set on black or purple).

In the Amateur S-ROC, Freddie Bedford, Mark Rohnock, Daulton Chouinard, Steven Garrison and Ed Thompson all made appearances in the top three during the event. When the power went off Steven got the big trophy followed by Daulton and Mark. Steven and Mark shared best segment (21) with fast lap going to Freddie (2.640).

Experienced S-ROC was, as expected, incredibly close as only 3-1/2 laps covered the top four finishers. We were all thrilled to see Count Gibson best this 21-entrant field. Count is one of those guys who supports the hobby, races hard every week and is always near the front. He edged Steve Bowman who was only a lap ahead of Bob Rondi-

none. Count also ran fast lap (2.468) with Bob getting best segment (36). A big THANK YOU to Bob Rondinone for the "Perpetual Trophy" that will feature the names of all our S-ROC winners.

WOMP RACERS: two of our three sponsors from last year's C-RACER GROSS-X WOMP CHALLENGE have stepped up and doubled their commitment! Mark December 19 on your calendars for this year's C-RACER GROSS-ONE. At least \$200 in prizes will be awarded in the WOMP classes alone! First in Amateur and Experience will each receive a trophy and \$25 in race bucks, with the remainder being paid out over the entire WOMP field. Race related items will also be awarded for "Best Appearing" in all classes. The event will also feature 4.5" cars and JK Products new East Coast Modified car. All races will be on the Oval.

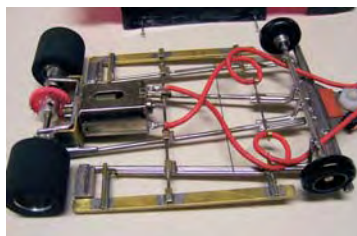
